



Standard Warranty for Solar/Backup Power Installation

This warranty is provided by Aspigon209 (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") for the solar installation performed at the customer's premises.

1. Compliance Guarantee

- 1.1 The Company warrants that the solar installation will be compliant with the Certificate of Compliance (COC) standards.
- 1.2 In the event that a third-party inspection reveals any non-compliance issues, the Company commits to addressing and rectifying these shortcomings at no additional cost to the customer, to ensure full compliance with COC standards.

2. Warranty Coverage

- 2.1 This warranty covers all workmanship and equipment related to the solar and backup power installation performed by the Company.
- 2.2 The warranty period shall commence from the date of installation completion and shall remain valid for one year, subject to the conditions outlined in this document.

3. Warranty Exclusions and Limitations

- 3.1 This warranty shall be considered null and void if any work, modifications, or changes are made to the solar/backup power installation by any party other than the Company, unless explicit written consent has been obtained from the Company prior to such alterations.
- 3.2 The Company shall not be held responsible for any damages, malfunctions, or performance issues arising from unauthorized modifications or interventions.

4. Warranty Claims Process

- 4.1 To make a warranty claim, the customer must contact the Company in writing, providing details of the issue and any relevant documentation.

- 5.1 The Company's liability under this warranty is limited to repair, replacement, or rectification of the installation to meet COC compliance standards.
